I hope that you all had a good summer. Now that your child is back and in Year 6 it is time to consider your choice of secondary school for next September. It always seems to be very early, but necessary to ensure you have every opportunity to choose the right school for your child.

As you are aware, all applications need to be made to Essex County Hall by the <u>31st October</u> at the latest. As parents, it is important that you meet this deadline otherwise your child will miss the opportunity to state their school of preference.

The staff, students and governors at Clacton County High School cordially invite future students along with their families to our **OPEN EVENING ON THURSDAY, 21**st **SEPTEMBER commencing at 4.00pm until 7.00pm**. The evening gives an opportunity to see the school, meet staff and students and hear presentations about our Admissions Policy and ethos.

The main aim of the evening is for you to see as much of the school as possible and to give you all the information you need to make the best choice of secondary school for your child. Short 20-minute presentations will take place in the Main Hall during the evening. There will be four presentations as follows:

Please do look around the school before and after your allocated presentation and speak to as many staff and students as you can to get their views on life at CCHS. A bell will sound at 6.50pm to alert you that the evening is about to finish and we would ask you to move directly to the exits and promptly leave the school site.

Parking on the school site is extremely limited, therefore, please can I ask you to park in the Leisure Centre car park and enter the school through the rear entrance, or park in the Walton Road area and come in through the front entrance.

We look forward to welcoming parents and prospective students to showcase the success of our students, both academically and via extra-curricular activities.

If you are unable to attend and/or you would prefer to see the school during a normal working day, there will be additional opportunities provided for parents to visit and have a general tour of the school. I look forward to meeting you on Thursday, 21st September.


