## CCHS Summer School

Thank you for booking a place for your child to join us for the CCHS Summer School. We are really looking forward to welcoming your child to CCHS. The Summer School will take place each day from Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> August until Friday, 13<sup>th</sup> August from 9.30am – 2.30pm. The drop off point and pick up point for students will be the playground adjacent to the main student entrance. Staff will be on hand to direct your child and to meet and greet them on arrival and for the pick-up. If you intend for your child to walk home alone, please issue with a note on the first day advising us accordingly.

Lunch will be provided each day (sandwich, snack and drink) however, we do request that each child brings with them a refillable water bottle, and if there are any specific dietary requirements, please feel free to provide a suitable packed lunch. Due to allergies we politely request that your child does not bring anything in containing nuts.

Your child should dress in appropriate and comfortable sports/PE kit for each day. Given that it will be the height of summer, your child should also bring sun cream and a light jacket in case it rains – the weather is one thing we cannot guarantee!

If your child requires medication during the day, this needs to be handed in to a member of staff on Monday morning, clearly labelled with your child's name and written instructions.

We are very excited to announce that, as part of the week, we will be arranging for a trip to Colchester Zoo. There is no charge for this trip and lunch will be provided. Groups will be visiting on either Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday. Your child will be given a timetable on the Monday morning detailing which day they will be going to the Zoo.

Please complete this [consent form](#) in order to give permission for your child to take part in the Zoo trip. Students will need to meet at 9am on the morning of the trip, outside the front entrance of the school, and will return to the Leisure Centre car park at approximately 2.45pm, traffic depending.

Students will also need to bring in a rucksack/bag each day as we will be giving them information and resources to use and take home each day, as well as for taking their belongings with them as they move around the school for different activities.

There will be time given for a complete tour of the school for all students; we hope that this will help to make them feel more confident and excited about attending in September. We will also finish the week with an awards assembly – celebrating the [CCHS PROUD values](#). Awards including stationery, books and Kindles will be given out to those students who have best demonstrated these values over the week.
