You are warmly invited to the Year 9 Parents' Evening on **Thursday, 7th March 2024** from 3.45 pm - 6.45 pm to discuss your child's progress with their teachers, and to have the opportunity to learn more about some options subjects your child may be interested in when making decisions about Key Stage 4 choices.

Bookable Appointments - English, Maths and Science

We are offering appointment-based face-to-face slots for English, Maths, and Science, these can be booked on our SchoolCloud system which will open for bookings from 6.00pm on Thursday, 29th February 2024. Please <u>click here</u> to book. Bookings will close at midday on Thursday, 7th March. Appointments will be 5 minutes in length to allow most parents the opportunity to speak to their child's teachers.

Please be aware that neither the teacher nor the parent will be able to extend this beyond the scheduled appointment length, in which case, if there are further questions, a follow-up email or telephone conversation with the teacher might be appropriate. All other Subjects

Teachers for all other subjects will be available for you to discuss your child's progress or to find out more about the subject, face-to-face, without appointments.

New Subject Options

Teachers representing new options: Business Studies, Child Development, Media, and Production Arts will also be available for you and your child to explore.

Sigma Sixth

Representatives from Sigma Sixth, the school's vibrant and successful sixth-form college, will also be present to provide information on the college and give advice on course options. Further information about post-16 pathways will also be available, notably around the collaborative VI6 (Six Six) provision that CCHS has developed.

Year 9 Reports

Year 9 reports will have been issued ahead of the parents' evening, and you may consider that you do not need to book appointments in English, Maths, and Science if your child is doing well, achieving highly and you have no pressing questions.

English, Maths, and Science appointments will be held in the School's main hall and our D block classrooms. All other activities will be in the Clouds restaurant area.



Student leaders and ambassadors will be available to assist and can offer tours of the Art and Music departments to view work and resources should your child be interested in taking or continuing with these subjects.

Please enter and leave the school through the Walton Road gates. As you approach the front of the school proceed around to the right and enter through the student entrance and left towards the Clouds Restaurant.

Parking on the school site will be minimal. If you park on Walton Road, please be considerate to our neighbours. Refreshments will be available free of charge.
