Year 9 Core Assessments - 7th-9th May

At the beginning of May, your child along with the rest of year 9 will sit assessments in English, Maths and Science in formal exam conditions. All assessments are an extremely important part of the preparation for GCSEs which begin in year 10, as they will help gauge progress so far and the individual student priorities for moving forward. The results of these assessments will be shared with you in their report which you will receive just before the Summer break. These assessments will also form part of the decision making for setting going into Year 10.

Each assessment is 1 hour in length and assesses their learning from Key Stage 3, so any topic learnt in years 7-9 could be assessed, links to BBC Bitesize can be found below. We therefore value your support in ensuring your child is well prepared for these assessments by encouraging them to complete independent revision at home as well as working hard during lessons.

Tuesday, 7th May	Science Assessment	Biology, Chemistry and Physics
Wednesday, 8th May	Maths Assessment	All topics. Students can also prepare for the test using the 'Independent Learning' tab on the Sparx Maths home screen. They can then select all KS3 topics from the dropdown menu.
Thursday, 9th May	English Assessment	Focus on Critical Reading, Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar
