Dear Parent/Carer

As promised please follow the link to your child's mock <u>timetable</u>, a hard copy has been given to students via tutor time this morning. You will see that the first mock exam is Wednesday, 12th June and their last mock paper is Monday, 1st July.

As previously communicated, the year 10 mock examinations are an extremely important part of the preparation for GCSE subject exams and also form part of the evidence used by teachers to make predicted grades. Your child will need these predicted grades to make applications to further education providers in the first term of year 11.

Should your child miss a mock exam they will score a '0' for that paper and therefore are more likely to get a lower grade overall. If this is in a subject with only one mock paper, this will result in a U grade ("Ungraded" - a failure to achieve a grade.) Please read through our <u>late to exams protocol</u> with your child so that the process is understood.

Please support your child to revise for and attend all scheduled mock examinations, coming prepared with the correct equipment, which is as follows:

- Black pen x2
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Rubber
- Highlighter pen for subjects such as English, history, geography, RE
- Scientific calculator for maths, science and geography papers

We know that many students have already been completing independent study through homework and revision. However if your child is yet to begin, details of what to revise and resources to support revision can be found here.
