## Year 11 Parents' Evening, Thursday, 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2025

You are warmly invited to the Year 11 Parents' Evening on Thursday, 2<sup>nd</sup> October from 3.45pm - 6.45pm to discuss your child's progress with their teachers to ensure the best outcome for your child's GCSE results and have as many options as possible for their future. The evening offers an important opportunity to find out how to support your child's learning at home and identify areas where they may need additional support as they head towards final exams.

The year 11 parents' evening is early in the school year, so that we can share with you important information about how best to support your child's progress in this important year.

#### **Appointment booking**

Appointment bookings will open from 6.00pm on Thursday, 18<sup>th</sup> September.
