Asda help tackle digital exclusion

Before Easter we were delighted to receive a number of new laptops, donated by Asda, as part of their national drive to help children who have limited access to a device or to the internet at home. These have now been distributed to a number of very grateful students.



The supermarket formed a partnership with technology provider Dell and invested £2.0m so that every Asda store in the UK can donate a number of laptops to a school in their local community. CCHS was chosen by the Clacton store to receive ten of their laptop and tech bundles which included a headset and a mobile internet dongle with a data allowance of 20gb from Asda's network partner Vodafone. The laptops also include a one-year warranty and technical support. Thank you Asda!



