We have shared on your child's Year 11 Google Classroom – two videos modelling how to complete effective revision (Part 1 -selecting, condensing, organising and integrating and Part 2 - recalling/retrieving and spaced practice) as well as a google sheet revision timetable that they can adapt to suit them. If you would like further information on how to support your child with their revision our parental engagement team will be on hand during our Year 11 Parent Evening.

Finally, we are very excited about launching our Passport to Prom initiative on Monday 8th January in preparation for the Prom on Thursday 20th June. The school Prom is a very important event for our Year 11 students and we want all of our students to be able to attend. However, attendance to Prom is dependent on your child attending all their scheduled exams, completing a minimum of 20 after school revision sessions, having at least 95% attendance during the Passport to Prom period, which is this year between 8th January and 24th May, and having exemplary behaviour during this period. Students who attend 30 or more after school revision sessions, over the 17-week period, will be entered into our prize draw which will be on Friday 24th May. Attending after school revision with the support of teachers is vital to exam success, however if your child is unable to attend after school revision or you have any questions regarding any of the above please contact us at admin@cchs.school.
