Please read this important <u>letter</u> from Deputy Headteacher – Mrs K Loosley

Mock exams replicate exam conditions providing a glimpse into the pressure, time constraints and atmosphere of the actual GCSEs. Mocks won't affect final GCSE scores but they are still important because they identify areas of the subject students may need to work on. They are an excellent self-awareness tool for students as well as giving teachers a clearer idea of where students are in their learning.

Year 11 Exams - Starting Tuesday, 7th May 2024

Exam Information Reminder:

All students need to attend in full school uniform. For the morning exams, we suggest that they are present at 8.45 am.

Essential exam equipment includes:

- Black pen x2
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Rubber
- Highlighter pen for subjects such as English, history, geography, RE
- Scientific calculator for maths, science, and geography papers

If your child has trouble sourcing any of this equipment including a calculator, please let the school know as soon as possible so that one can be made available.

A Scientific calculator is a vital piece of equipment for the maths and physics exams. If your child doesn't have one or forgets to bring one they should speak with their teacher.

Clacton Police Station Open Day on Saturday 11 May 2024 from 11am to 2pm.

Join the District Commander, Chief Inspector Ella Latham, and her team at our police station on Beatrice Road and meet the people who work to keep our community safe.

There will be lots of police-themed activities for the younger members of our community to get involved in as well as demonstrations from some of their specialist policing teams. The police will be giving an insight into their work and the type of equipment they use to protect people in Essex and catch criminals. And, of course, they will have different Essex Police vehicles on hand for people to get a closer look at, plus some police uniform to try on too.

The Police will be joined by colleagues including Essex County Fire and Rescue Service, Tendring District Council, RNLI Clacton Lifeboat and Safer Essex Roads Partnership as well as several charitable organisations that they regularly work with such as Next Chapter, Community Voluntary Services Tendring (CVST), Neighbourhood Watch and Essex Search & Rescue.

No booking needed. Refreshments will be available to purchase on the day, with all profits going to support local charities. Parking isn't available at the police station or on Beatrice Road, but there are several public car parks just a short walk from the station.
