## **Opt in to Student Rewards**

#### **PROUD+ Rewards - CCHS Virtual Shop**

We are proud to announce that **hundreds of students have gained hundreds of proud+ points** this term. Students will soon be able to choose prizes in the virtual shop. PROUD+ points are awarded for going 'over and above' in lessons and around the school. Categories include: Perseverance, Responsibility, Unity, Opportunity, and Diversity. Proud+ reward prizes will include gift cards, cinema tickets, footballs, dinner passes, and more! Instructions on how to pre-select prizes will be sent via email. Proud+ point scores, minus any negative behaviour points determine the virtual shop spent value.

## **Proud points**

Thank you to all the parents and carers for supporting your children and the school, encouraging your child to opt in to lessons to the best of their ability, to overcome hurdles, and build resilience. Thank you for sending them to school in the correct uniform, on time, and with the right equipment. PROUD points are awarded to students for attending lessons and registration (form time), for having the right equipment, and for conducting themselves safely (good behaviour). Students are awarded 6 points for each session, there are 4 lessons and 1 registration per day (5 sessions) students can gain 30 points per day and 150 points per week. This means that a certain number of proud points can be guaranteed with good attendance and good behaviour. Students not attending school will unfortunately not achieve any points.

## **Negative points**

Negative points are issued on levels 1-5. These are awarded to students when their behaviour, or punctuality is not in line with the student code of conduct - Ready, Respectful and Safe.

Proud points can result in an invitation to attend end-of-term reward trips. This is typically a free trip to Clacton Pier or Clacton Cinema in school time (3 negative points or more, in a term, will mean that your child misses out on this opportunity)
