When the modules are connected together there is a joint this needs to be insulated and sealed. By doing so it prevents the ingress of water. This process is completed with the tape and joint of the connection points and steel beams/columns.



Within the sports hall the process is the same. Below the plasterboard is a fire lining board. All of these need to be cut to fit the steel sections. These will shortly been tape and jointed and then painted to design.



The ceilings in the sports hall and modules are suspended ceilings; however the sports hall ceiling is specifically designed for a sports hall – this ensures its security and absorbs sound.
