The Literacy and Numeracy Catch-Up Premium provides schools with an additional £500 for each Year 7 pupil who did not achieve at least the minimum standard in English and/or Maths at the end of Key Stage 2. The table below details how funding was distributed in 2019-20. In 2020 to 2021 funding that would have been allocated to schools for the year 7 catch-up premium has been included in the catch-up premium allocated to the school by the DFE following this year's lockdown due to Covid 19.

As a result, the funding provided to catch-up was used to support online programmes and mentoring during the lockdown period.
