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PE/DANCE KIT

- From Monday 22nd March, all students will be able to attend school in their PE or Dance kit on the day of their practical sessions only.
- The day in which this will occur, will be communicated by the teacher to their class.
- Students should attend school in the correct PE or Dance kit, with no variations permitted unless a genuine reason is provided via email from parent or note from parent.



WHAT DOES PE/DANCE KIT LOOK LIKE AT KEY STAGE 3?

Boys: White polo shirt (with or without logo), rugby shirt, navy blue or black shorts, royal blue socks. Trainers and boots (depending on activity). No hoodies or other jackets permitted.

Girls: White polo shirt (with or without school logo), CCHS navy fleece, navy blue or black shorts, royal blue socks. Trainers and boots (depending on activity). No hoodies or other jackets permitted. Strictly no leggings.

Tracksuit bottoms (blue or black) are permitted for both boys and girls in cold weather.

Base layers (under armour) can be worn.

Blazers must be worn over PE kit in year 7 and 8.



WHAT DOES PE KIT LOOK LIKE AT KEY STAGE 4?

Boys and Girls - PE:

- Navy polo shirt (with or without logo)
- One of: Rugby shirt, CCHS fleece, or the new Errea ¼ zip top in navy (CCHS embroided) (see pictures right)
- navy blue or black shorts (blue or black jogging bottoms permitted in cold weather).
- royal blue football socks or white sport socks.
- Base layers (under armour) can be worn.
- Trainers and boots (depending on activity).
- No hoodies or other jackets permitted.
- Blazers must be brought to school year 9-10.





WHAT DOES DANCE KIT LOOK LIKE YEAR 9-11?



- Dance: Black polo shirt, CCHS dance black jumper, black leggings or black joggers. Trainers. No hoodies or other jackets permitted.
- Blazers must be worn over dance kit in year 9 and 10.
